






Step #1 - Visit https://www.healthymatsu.org/





Step #2 - Select "How We Fund" > "Scholarships" > "Academic Scholarships"






Step #3 - After carefully reading the "Academic Scholarships" landing page, click on the apply link (only available from 1/15 until 3/15)






Step #4 - Click on the "Create an Account" link






Step #5 — Account activation. Enter the email address you will use for the academic scholarship application process and click "Send Email." Please do not use an MSBSD-issued email as you will not have access to this once you graduate.






Step #6 - Check your email account for the link to activate your account. Click the link you receive and then enter your email and create your own password.






Step #7 - Once you have logged in, scroll to the bottom of the page and click the blue "Start a new 2025-2026 Academic Scholarship" link






Step #8 – Select "Add New Organization (the school you are attending)






Step #9 – Enter your school's name and click on the "Start 2025-2026 Academic Scholarship" button






Step #10 – Scroll to the bottom of the page.

Required Documents

To complete your application, you will need to upload three documents. Before you start, please be sure you have the following documents available:


- 1) Your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) confirmation email. Once you receive your FAFSA confirmation email, save it as a PDF or JPEG and upload it to your scholarship application. Click here to see a sample FAFSA confirmation email. If you have not completed the FAFSA, you must do so before completing your Mat-Su Health Foundation scholarship application. Please note, we cannot process your application without the current 2025-2026 FAFSA confirmation email, do not submit your 2024-2025 FAFSA.
- 2) Proof of the Cost of Attendance for the school you plan to attend. This must include tuition, fees, books, room and board, etc. for the upcoming academic year. It can be in the form of a letter from the school you plan to attend or a screen shot from their website listing the official budget for Cost of Attendance, not to include summer course costs. Click here to see an example of proof of Cost of Attendance.
- 3) Unofficial copy of your most recent transcript (high school, GED, college, or university).

You can save your application and come back to it if needed





Final Step – Review & submit! You'll know each stage is complete when you see a check mark in the circle. Finally, click the green "Submit" button.
