### Required Documents

To complete your application, you will need to upload three documents. Before you start, please be sure you have the following documents available:

- ➔ 1) Your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) confirmation email. Once you receive your FAFSA confirmation email, save it as a PDF or JPEG and upload it to your scholarship application. [Click here to see a sample FAFSA confirmation email](#). If you have not completed the FAFSA, you must do so before completing your Mat-Su Health Foundation scholarship application. **Please note, we cannot process your application without the current 2025-2026 FAFSA confirmation email, do not submit your 2024-2025 FAFSA.**
- ➔ 2) Proof of the Cost of Attendance for the school you plan to attend. This must include tuition, fees, books, room and board, etc. for the upcoming academic year. It can be in the form of a letter from the school you plan to attend or a screen shot from their website listing the official budget for Cost of Attendance, not to include summer course costs. - ➔ 3) Unofficial copy of your most recent transcript (high school, GED, college, or university).
